Once all questions have been answered and the results assessed, participants who meet the required scoring criteria are officially certified.

Certified individuals receive an **official IACBAM Certificate** and are automatically recognised as Associates of IACBAM.

Certified professionals will learn to:

- Classify CBAM relevant goods and structure data consistently
- Manage embedded emissions using actual and default values
- Design compliant CBAM workflows with proper documentation and audit trails
